

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in a special meeting via Zoom on **May 24, 2023** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson, Wyoming, to consider a time-sensitive agreement. The meeting was called to order at 2:21 p.m.

Commission present (via Zoom): Natalia Macker, Vice-Chair, Mark Newcomb, and Wes Gardner were present.

ACTION ITEMS

1. Consideration of USDA Grant Agreement - Notice of Award

Brenda Ashworth, Superintendent of Solid Waste and Recycling, presented to the Board for consideration of approval a Grant Agreement with U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) for Composting and Food Waste Reduction funding for air knife density separator equipment and associated education and outreach for the Teton County food waste composting program.

There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Newcomb and seconded by Commissioner Gardner to approve the USDA Composting and Food Waste Reduction Grant Agreement in the amount of \$300,000, with a FY24 cash match of \$60,000 and an in-kind match of \$40,000, for a total project cost of \$400,000. Vice-Chair Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
