

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular meeting on **May 30, 2023** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:02 a.m.

Commission present: Luther Propst, Chair, Natalia Macker, Vice-Chair, Mark Newcomb, Greg Epstein, and Wes Gardner were present.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Epstein and seconded by Commissioner Newcomb to adopt the agenda with the addition of a letter to the Bridger Teton National Forest concerning Johnny County Road. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment.

**ACTION ITEMS**

1. Consideration of Payment of County Vouchers

A motion was made by Commissioner Newcomb and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the May 30, 2023 county voucher run in the amount of \$731,687.03 with the note that there is a significant voucher for Anderson Mason Dale Architects for the Courthouse project. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

2. Consent Agenda for Administrative Items

a. 24-Hour Liquor Permits

i. Jackson Hole Still Works - Snake River Fest

A request for approval of an application for a 24-Hour Manufacturer's Off-Premise Permit submitted by Jackson Hole Still Works for the Snake River Fest 2023 to be held June 3, 2023 (description below).

There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Macker and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the 24-hour manufacturer's off-premise permit submitted by Jackson Hole Still Works for the Snake River Fest 2023 to take place at Astoria Hot Springs, 25 Johnny Counts Road Jackson, WY on June 3, 2023 with the permit being valid for a 24-hour period per day. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

b. SLIB Drawdowns

a. Tax Corrections

i. Cantwell Trust

Melissa Shinkle, Teton County Assessor, presented to the Board for consideration of approval a Tax Roll Correction for Danny V. Cantwell Trust and Deanna M Cantwell Revocable Trust.

There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Macker and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the tax roll correction as presented by the assessor for Danny V. Cantwell Trust, and Deana M. Cantwell Revocable Trust in the amount of \$8,702.27. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

ii. Cancellation of Uncollected Personal Property Taxes

Ms. Shinkle presented for consideration of approval a request to approve the cancellation of uncollected personal property taxes.

There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Macker and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the cancellation of past due personal property taxes in the amount of \$7701.74 pursuant to Wyoming State Statute 39-313-110(a). Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

2. Consideration of Proposed Outgoing Commissioner Correspondence

a. Thank-You Letter to Department of Interior

A motion was made by Commissioner Epstein and seconded by Commissioner Macker to approve the letter to the Department of Interior regarding the Bureau of Reclamation as it pertains to Jackson Lake Dam. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

b. Access to Snake River Sporting Club on Hoback South Road and Johnny Counts Road

Dave Gustafson, Road & Levee Manager, and Matt Carr, Sheriff, answered questions from the Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Newcomb and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the letter with the amendments discussed, including removing the second paragraph with the exception of the first sentence; placing the first sentence of the second paragraph at the beginning of the letter, and changing the first sentence of the first paragraph to say, "We are concerned about snake river sporting club using Johnny Counts Road," etc. Chair Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
