RESOLUTION # 18-037

RESCISION OF SEPTEMBER 21, 2018 PARTIAL FIRE CLOSURE FOR UNINCORPORATED AREA OF TETON COUNTY PROHIBITING OPEN FIRES

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute §35-9-301 allows upon the recommendation of the County Fire Warden for the Board of County Commissioners to prohibit open fire in the unincorporated areas of Teton County for such period of time as the board of county commissioners may deem necessary and proper; and

WHEREAS, the County Fire Warden advised that the fire danger in the unincorporated area of Teton County was extreme due to the excessive amount of inflammable material and dry conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Teton County Board of County Commissioners entered an Order for a Partial Fire Closure for the Unincorporated Areas of Teton County on September 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the County Fire Warden has now advised the Teton County Board of County Commissioners that a partial fire closure is no longer warranted.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body of the County of Teton that the Partial Fire Closure Resolution dated September 21, 2018 is hereby rescinded and the Partial Fire Closure shall end at 11 a.m. M.S.T. on today's date, Friday, October 5, 2018.
