

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on **November 5, 2018** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:08am.

Commission present: Mark Newcomb Chair, Natalia Macker Vice-Chair, Greg Epstein, Smokey Rhea, and Paul Vogelheim.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Rhea and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to adopt today's agenda as it stands. Chair Newcomb called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Brian Schilling, Pathways Coordinator, addressed the Board regarding the wayfinding sign, increased bike traffic on Fish Creek Road, bike shop promotes Fish Creek Road as a good biking option, working with the Bike Shops, possibly changing the double yellow line in some parts, open to removal of the sign.

Discussion between the Board and Mr. Schilling included the wayfinding sign, concerned residents, contacting the Bike Shops.
