Subject: Hoback River Bridge BROS-OC22031
construction project final acceptance

Statement / Purpose: Consideration of approving Acceptance Certificate LP-3 to the Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) stating that Teton County has inspected the newly re-constructed Hoback River Bridge and accepts the project.

Background / Description (Pros & Cons): In 2005, Teton County requested WYDOT replace the Hoback Bridge at Rogers Point as part of the Bridge Replacement Off-System (BROS) program. The County entered into a cooperative agreement with WYDOT at that time. After overcoming right of way challenges, the project was let to bid in August 2016 and Cannon Builders, Inc. was awarded the contract. Cannon completed their work in 2017. On November 1, 2017, Road and Levee Manager Dave Gustafson, Engineering Manager Amy Ramage, and Sean O'Malley inspected the completed project with WYDOT and Cannon personnel. Staff noted several minor cleanup items that were subsequently resolved within one week. Staff believes the project is 100% complete.

Stakeholder Analysis & Involvement: Teton County and WYDOT have worked cooperatively on this project.

Fiscal Impact: Other than routine maintenance, there should be no additional costs associated with this project. The total design and construction costs were approximately \$2,135,352.47 with Teton County's share \$203,072.02. Teton County also paid Mr. Rod Lewis \$192,750 for right of way. The County's total cost is approximately \$395,822.

Staff Impact: Minimal

Staff Input / Recommendation: Staff has inspected the bridge and believes the project has been completed in accordance with plans and specification prepared by WYDOT.
