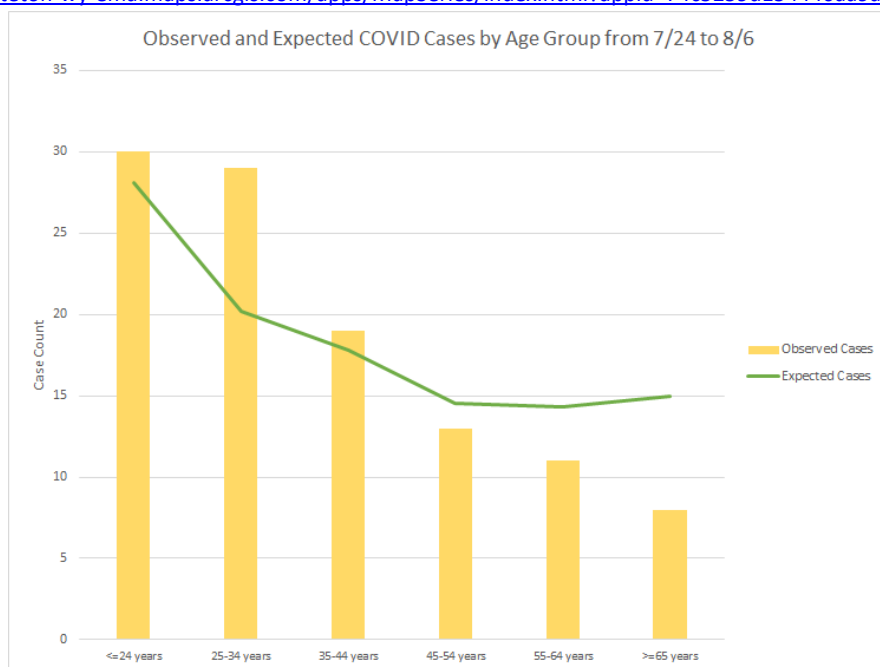


Health Department and Health Order Updates August 7, 2020

- 2) In the past two weeks (7/24 to 8/6) there were 110 new cases reported, up from 100 cases in two weeks prior.
 - 26 cases attributable to community spread (24%)
 - 78 cases had close contact with another known case (71%)
 - 13 cases had a history of travel (12%) – May be included in other 2 categories also.
