

Health Department and Health Order Updates August 28, 2020



- 1) State announces 11th continuation of Health Orders.

- 2) Teton District Public Health Order #20-6 (requiring adults to wear face coverings) and Teton District Public Health Recommendation #9 (encouraging early closure of bars and restaurants) have both been extended through August 31, 2020. <https://www.tetoncountywy.gov/2064/COVID-19-Health-Orders>
- 3) In the past two weeks (8/14 to 8/27) there were 46 new cases reported.
 - 17 cases attributable to community spread (37%).
 - 26 cases had close contact with another known case (57%).
 - 9 cases had a history of travel (20%) – May be included in other 2 categories also.
