

Special Events Treat & Release Tracking Form- Jackson Hole Fire/EMS

Treat and Release (T & R) refers to the **non-emergent onsite treatment of a patient with minor injury/illness** that **requires only basic first aid** and does not require transport to a health care facility (ex: minor orthopedic injuries, minor lacerations, heat exhaustion, etc).

For complete guidelines, see JHFEMS Protocol 17-3, *Treat and Release of minor injury or Illness*.

Patients requiring assessment or treatment beyond basic first aid should involve transport or ePCR documentation of a patient refusal.

T&R should be avoided and caution exercised when:

Special Event name

Associated with alteration in mental status or behavior, intoxication or the patient is mentally ill

Vital signs are not normal (BP, pulse, respiratory rate)

Patient has abdominal pain, chest pain or neck pain or there exists bleeding in a patient taking anticoagulants

Patient is an unaccompanied minor or pregnant

Situation has potential legal implications or the scene is unstable/threatening (e.g., assault, domestic violence, sexual assault, illicit drug use)
