



**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TETON COUNTY**

**(Salaries of Elected Public Officials – Clerk, Clerk of District Court, Treasurer, Sheriff, Assessor, Coroner)**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 14, Section 3 of the Wyoming Constitution, the Wyoming Legislature shall fix the salaries of county officers.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners is required to set the salaries of various public officials in accordance with Wyoming Statute §18-3-107; and

**WHEREAS**, the current annual salaries of the following public officials of Teton County are:

<u>Official</u>	<u>Salary</u>
Assessor	\$100,000
Clerk	\$100,000
Clerk of District Court	\$100,000
Sheriff	\$100,000
Treasurer	\$100,000
Coroner	\$ 50,000

**WHEREAS**, Wyoming Statute §18-3-107 allows county commissioners to only adjust county public official salaries every four (4) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wyoming Legislature amended Wyoming Statute §18-3-107 in 2022 through House Bill 91 to increase the maximum salary of the county officers listed to not more than the salary authorized for a circuit court judge in Wyoming Statute §5-1-110 from and after January 2, 2023, and

**WHEREAS**, a circuit court judge in Wyoming makes \$145,000 per Wyoming Statute §5-1-110; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Coroner salary shall remain at \$50,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the current annual salaries of public officials of Teton County shall increase On January 2 of 2023 as delineated below.

**NOW THEREFORE**, having duly met at a regular meeting, April 12, 2022, and considered the matter, it is

**RESOLVED**, that the following public officials of Teton County shall receive the following annual salaries, beginning January 2, 2023:

Assessor	\$145,000
Clerk	\$145,000
Clerk of District Court	\$145,000
Sheriff	\$145,000
Treasurer	\$145,000
Coroner	\$ 50,000

SIXTY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING  
2022 BUDGET SESSION

AN ACT relating to counties; amending the salaries of specified county officers; repealing obsolete salary language; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-107(a)(i) by creating a new subparagraph (D) is amended to read:

**18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers; additional compensation prohibited; exception as to traveling and other expenses; compensation of county commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks, stenographers and other assistants.**

(a) County officers shall be paid as follows:

(i) The county assessor, part-time county and prosecuting attorneys, part-time county attorneys, county clerk, clerk of district court, county sheriff and county treasurer in their respective counties shall receive as annual salaries:

(D) From and after January 2, 2023 not more than the salary authorized for a circuit court judge in W.S. 5-1-110.

**Section 2.** W.S. 18-3-107(a)(i)(B) is repealed.
