Social Determinants of Health	
Theme: Access to Healthcare	
Who	The theme impacts everyone (all gender, races, ages, abilities, etc). Sub populations include women, children, immigrants, and seasonal workers.
How	The impact of this issue is widespread as it impacts all populations and connects to other issues of time, travel, education, and prevention.
What	Elements that contribute to this theme include Wyoming Medicaid, lack of providers, lack of resources, transportation, language and cultural barriers, and income as a determinant of Medicaid eligibility
When and Where	Rural and outlying communities, as population increases need increases, need higher during emergent situations.
