Teton County/Jackson Parks and Recreation Begins Transition to Winter Operations

September 25, 2025, Jackson, Wyo. – Teton County/Jackson Parks and Recreation has begun the seasonal transition from summer to winter operations at all Town and County Parks.

Staff have begun winterization of all irrigation systems and will begin increased agronomic practices over the next month to support healthy landscapes and soil conditions throughout the winter season.

Seasonal Facility Closures

In order to ensure the successful winterization of Town/County Park facilities and protection of community assets, all seasonal restrooms and water fountains at Town and County Parks will close on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, with the following exceptions:

- Miller Park and Emily's Pond Restrooms – remain open year-round.
- Stilson Lot Restrooms – close October 15, 2025, and will reopen for winter operations in November.
- Wilson and South Park Boat Ramp Restrooms – close October 31, 2025.

Recreation Facilities

- Hard courts (tennis, basketball, etc.) at all Town and County Parks are scheduled to close on Wednesday, October 15, but may remain open longer depending on weather conditions.
- The Owen Bircher Riding Arena will be available for reserved use through Tuesday, September 30, 2025, and accessible (weather permitting) until October 15.
- The seasonal Dog Park at the Teton County Fairgrounds is anticipated to open in the first week of November.
