When Electrical Permits are Required

Electrical Permits are required when there is an associated building permit or miscellaneous permit for new construction, remodels, and additions. The following electrical installations would also require an electrical permit:

1. Anytime the scope of work exceeds 20 man hours.
2. Installation of any new branch circuit(s).
3. Any new wiring installed in construction of new walls, ceilings, etc.
4. Anytime the classification of a room is changed. (i.e. garage to a bedroom, etc.)
5. Kitchen and bathroom remodels that involve changes to the existing electrical system. (i.e. addition of GFCI protected receptacles, electric floor heat, etc.)
6. Any new service, panel, sub-panel.
7. Any service change or panel replacement.
8. New hot tub, spa, and pool installations.
9. Hot tub, spa, and pool renovations that involve changes to equipotential bonding, pool equipment, etc., and any additions in the restricted areas of a hot tub, spa, and pool.
10. Any installation of heat trace.
11. Any installation of solar (PV), energy storage system (ESS), wind, generator, etc.
12. Any electrical work conducted in a classified location.

When Not Required

1. Changing out devices or fixtures.
2. Scope of work does not exceed 20 man hours and does not meet any other requirements above.
3. Addition of receptacles, switching, lights etc. on existing branch circuits and the scope of work does not exceed 20 man hours.
