Board of Commissioners Action Summary

This section summarizes major actions taken by the Teton County Board of Commissioners. The Agenda Center on the County's website contains meeting minutes for a more detailed record of discussions and decisions.

- At the regular meeting on February 6, 2018, the Board of Commissioners approved the 3-Year Snake River Management Plan that was designed collaboratively with the community with the goal of providing quality river recreation opportunities while being respectful and compatible with the river as a natural resource. - At a special meeting on March 2, 2018, the Board of Commissioners approved a Special Event Application for the Dead & Co. to perform on August 18 and 19, 2018. - At the regular meeting on March 6, 2018, a Conditional Use Permit, Zoning Compliance Verification, and Variance for the Teton Raptor Center expansion was approved. More information, including staff reports, is available at: www.tetoncountywy.gov/DocumentCenter/View/6137.
- Consideration of a Cooperative Agreement with the Wyoming Department of Transportation for Tribal Trails Road was continued to the April 10, 2018, regular meeting.

Engage 2017 Update

The Engage 2017 planning process is in its fourth and final phase. Staff is in the process of presenting draft updates to Housing Rules & Regulations, Housing Requirements, Town Zoning & Parking, and Natural Resource Protections.

To date, 8 public comment events have been held (3 Spanish-speaking, 5 English-speaking) and 5 surveys have been completed, generating over 1,200 responses from community members. In addition, multiple County Commission, Town Council, Planning Commission, and Natural Resource Stakeholder Group public meetings have been held over the course of 9 months to provide feedback and inform the updates.

U.S. Passport Execution Fee to Increase

The U.S. Department of State is increasing the "passport execution fee" from \$25 to \$35 beginning on April 2, 2018. This fee increase only applies to applicants using the DS-11 form, including first time applicants over 16, children under 16, and re-applications due to a lost or stolen passport.
