

Teton County Board of Commissioners Meeting

Action Report – 9/4/2018

A summary of actions taken at regular Teton County Board of Commission meetings

The Teton County Board of Commissioners approved items 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14 as part of their consent [agenda](#) today, as well as the following items that were discussed at the meeting:

 - Multiple options for action were proposed in the staff report for this item – the Board chose to remand the recommendations back to the committee for further work toward consensus, with the following motion:
 - To remand the WPLI recommendations to the existing committee and direct them to, with facilitation and under the current charter, using the MAWG proposal as a platform, return to the BCC within 30 days with a single recommendation supported by at least 66% or a 2/3 majority of the group, with dissenting statements included as appropriate, with the understanding that if a single recommendation cannot be reached, the Board intends to advance no recommendation.
