Statement / Purpose:

2019 Liquor License Renewals per WS 12-4-104. Approval of liquor license renewals for two previously postponed renewals (see details below)

Pursuant to WS 12-4-104 (b) "If a renewal or transfer hearing, the hearing shall be held no later than thirty (30) days preceding the expiration date of the license or permit." The current licenses expire on January 6, 2019.
